

**Rock Mechanics and Rock Engineering: Structures on and in rock masses**  
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Anna Maria Ferrero is Associate Professor in Geotechnical Engineering, at Parma University since 2002 and she has been researcher at the Polytechnic di Torino between 1992 and 2002. In 1993 she ended her PhD at the Polytechnic di Torino and in 1995 she obtained the Diploma of Imperial College (DIC) of London in Rock Mechanics.

Her research field is rock mechanics and it includes the development and application of characterization and modelling methods for the study of the stability conditions of natural slopes and underground excavations with continuous and discontinuous methods validated by the comparison with experimental measures performed with standard as well as innovative tools.

Her researches are carried on by experimental tests, numerical modelling and theoretical studies and are witnessed by more than 100 papers on international journals, national and international conferences.

She is involved in several research projects financed by private and public companies.
